Welcome to the 2010 Season

The Board is excited to welcome all new and returning players & families to the 2010 season. This year we are fielding 18 teams from U6 to U12. As you can imagine, this is quite a task. In order to make this the best possible season for players and families, we would like to share some information with you:

The site has been completely redesigned and will be used to post a variety of information as it becomes available. We would appreciate your feedback so we can make it as useful to you as possible.

Kid Safe: The Board takes the safety of every player very seriously. All LRYs volunteers undergo a background check via the Kid Safe program.

Practices: Practices may commence on or after August 16th. Coaches will communicate the specific days and times. Please help the coach by having your player at practice on time or even a few minutes early. Do not drop off any player at practice and leave the area, or have someone else pick them up, unless prior arrangements have been made with the coach.

Games: The first games will be Saturday, September 4th. All games will take place at the Seacoast United fields here in town. This is an exciting opportunity for all our players, and a responsibility for all of us. Please be sure to pick up water bottles, snack containers or other debris after games or practices.

Jewelry: For reasons of safety, no jewelry of any kind, including earrings, may be worn by players during practices or games.

Sportsmanship: We are all here to help each player learn and develop to the best of their ability, to teach the game and sportsmanlike conduct. At no time will dangerous or inappropriate behavior be tolerated by players, coaches and other volunteers or spectators.

Fields: As mentioned above, all games will take place at Seacoast United – for the 1st time. Please bear with any logistical problems we may have in making the best use of this facility and, of course, help us by picking up loose materials at the end of practices and games.

Cancellations: Coaches will be notified by 8am, and notice will also be posted on the website. In the event of a cancellation we will play the same schedule on Sunday.

Picture day: This information will be available soon.

Fund Raiser: Annually, LRYs has conducted a fund raiser (Kicking Derby) to help with the purchase of uniforms and equipment, and to keep registration costs low. This year we are looking at doing something new and exciting – additional information will be available soon!

Closing Ceremonies: Information will be forthcoming in September.
